Morning Meeting:	The First and Second Class teachers will be posting a morning meeting video everyday this week on Seesaw so be sure to watch them!				
Reading:	Read for at least ten minutes.				
Spellings:	Write out your spellings using Look, Read, Cover, Write, Check. You could also choose two or three of the words to write sentences with				
Tables:	Write out your tables using Look, Cover, Write, Check. You could try making it a little more challenging by mixing up the order of the tables.				
Movement Break:	Take regular movement breaks. You could try a <u>Go Noodle</u> <u>here</u> or you could do ten jumping jacks.				
Language Fortnight:	It is Mother Language and Multi-Language Fortnight in Citywest ETNS. Everyday we would like the children to complete a task on our Mother Language and Multi-Language Fortnight.				

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Monday:

- 1. <u>Maths:</u> Remember 'Adding 10 at Super Speed?' We're going to learn to add even trickier numbers at Super Speed! See seesaw for our activities.
- 2. <u>English</u>: Last week we looked at verbs. This week we will be looking at another type of word, an adverb. Check out Martha's video and activity on Seesaw.
- 3. <u>Gaeilge</u>: This week we're going to look at the theme of éadaí in our Irish activities. Éadaí means clothes. Today we are going to go back over how to say the words for different types of clothes and we will go over how to say:

- 2. English: Today we will try out some more adverb work on Seesaw.
- 3. <u>Science:</u> Look at the video on seesaw to learn about the body parts of a mystery minibeast. Which one could it be?
- 4. <u>Language Fortnight</u>: It is Mother Language and Multi-Language Fortnight in Citywest ETNS. Everyday we would like the children to complete a task on our <u>Mother Language and Multi-Language Fortnight</u>.

Bonus: Why not create a block graph of all the minibeasts you come across? You can look at the graph below (Graph 1) to see how you can layout your graph in your copy. If you liked, you could stick it up on your fridge, and fill it in as the week goes on!

Wednesday:

- 1. <u>Maths:</u> Let's stretch our Adding Skills even more! See seesaw for activities.
- 2. <u>English</u>: It's time for some creative writing. A little like last week, today we will use adverbs to write a poem. Go to Seesaw for your instructions.
- 3. <u>Gaeilge:</u> Go to Seesaw for Martha's video and today's activity. Today we are going to learn how to answer the question:
