<u>Daily Tasks</u>	
Morning Meeting:	The First and Second Class teachers will be posting a morning meeting video everyday this week on Seesaw so be sure to watch them!
Reading:	Read for at least ten minutes a day.
Spellings:	Write out your spellings using <i>Look, Read, Cover, Write, Check</i> . You could also choose two or three of the words to write sentences with
Tables:	Write out your tables using <i>Look, Cover, Write, Check</i> . You could try making it a little more challenging by mixing up the order of the tables.
Movement Break:	Take regular movement breaks. You could try a Go Noodle here or you could do ten jumping jacks.
Language Fortnight:	It is the second week of Diversity Fortnight in Citywest ETNS. Everyday we would like the children to complete a task on our Diversity Fortnight page.

Monday:

1. **Maths:** Go to Seesaw for an introduction to halves. We will also complete page 114 in Planet Maths.
2. **English:** This week we are going to look at antonyms/opposites. Go to Seesaw for today's activity.

3. Gaeilge: This week we are looking at a new theme in Gaeilge called sa bhaile which means home. Go to Seesaw for today's activity.

4. Diversity Fortnight: It is Diversity Fortnight in Citywest ETNS. Everyday we would like the children to complete a task on our [Diversity Fortnight page](#).

Bonus: 5 of your spelling words have the "oy" spelling pattern. Can you think of some more? Write them and draw a picture to match them.
